- 1. Potential Expenses for remaining 2023 Budget, 2024 Budget Planning
  - -General Fund, left for this year \$53,444.00; after revenues collected minus expenses through year end
  - -Schedule separate meeting to discuss water/conservation, Thursday 10/12
  - -Email upgrades, Microsoft 365 for employee's/board, put in effect prior to year-end, potential cost \$1,500.00 P.D. will need a different type of 365 due to information they encounter, will decrease from 8 users to 4
  - -Public Works, replace Dodge truck would be top priority, determine a max amount that Kyle can spend on a new truck at auction prior to 12/15/2023
  - -P.D. is missing 2 MDT, possibly donated one to co responders, will continue to look for and clean things out If we hire 2 more officers, will only need to replace 1 MDT, currently have 3. Vehicles, current lease payoff due is \$22,000.00, and P.D. wants to add at least 1 more vehicle. Definitely need to payoff current lease. Rick has looked at purchasing vs. leasing options. 2024 budget should be close to the same as 2023, Lance has started researching/applying for grants
  - -One million dollars in savings, we do have that resource if needed
  - -Unsure of what the final amount will be from Weld County, 2023 was about \$30,000. less than 2022
  - -Cathy will verify with auditor, can we do a transfer from Savings to general fund if final from Weld County is less than expected
  - -P.D. also plans to return/sell/trade a number of weapons, will keep the AR15's, get rid of the shot guns
