The Town of Nunn State of Colorado

Advisement of Rights to persons appearing before the Municipal Court of the Town of Nunn.

The matters before the court are arraignments for first appearance in court. The court shall advise each defendant of his constitutional rights (generally as a group) and advise each individual present of the specific charges of the complaint when called before the bench.

You Have the Right:

- 1. To engage counsel to represent you before the court, at your own expense.
- 2. To a reasonable continuance to engage legal counsel prior to entering a plea in the matter before the court.
- 3. To the presumption of innocence until each and every element of the offense with which you are charged has been proven beyond a reasonable doubt by the Town.
- 4. To remain silent; however, if you choose to waive your right to remain silent, whatever you say may be used against you in this court.
- 5. To testify or not to testify on your own behalf.
- 6. Nunn Municipal Code: To a trial by jury; however, this right must be exercised by a written jury demand and the payment of \$25.00 advance jury fee within 10 days after arraignment or entry of plea.
- 7. Model Traffic Code: 2.36.070-Traffic Infractions-Trial by Judge only.
- 8. To appeal a decision and finding of guilt by this court upon trial, go to the District Court for Weld County.
- 9. To cross-examine witnesses called to testify against you.
- 10. To have witnesses subpoenaed to testify for you.
- 11. To be advised that the maximum penalties that may be imposed by the Nunn Municipal Court are a \$2,650.00 fine or for certain offenses other than traffic infractions up to 1 year in jail or both upon conviction.
- 12. To be advised that upon conviction of certain traffic offenses, points may be assessed against your driving record by the Division of Motor Vehicles of the State of Colorado.
