Parade Rules of Entry

- 1. All float participants must check in with official Nunn Days parade organizer upon arrival. (Failure to check in may result in exclusion of activity.)
- 2. All float entries should be built on a pick-up truck bed, farm wagon, flatbed truck or any other trailer deemed acceptable by the coordinator. The entry cannot be higher than 18 feet, measured upward from ground/street level. All floats must be completed prior to parade.
- All entries will line up on Lincoln between 7th Street and CR 98 (excluding livestock). The livestock parking and prep area will be located at the Town Tree Dump. Entries may begin lining up at 8:00 A.M. on Saturday August 23rd. Staging will take place between 8:00 AM and 8:30 AM. Any entries who arrive after 8:45AM may be denied entry. You will be issued an entry number prior to the day of the parade.
- 4. All floats must be able to travel the <u>entire</u> parade route and may not, in any case, cause slowing or otherwise delay the parade movement. The entering party will be responsible for transporting the float to and from the parade in accordance with proper highway and safety codes.
- 5. In case of possible inclement weather, check local TV stations prior to leaving home. Contact Joseph Kelly or our Facebook page for more information.
