Discussion:

- 1. Central Square for Nunn PD
 - -Chief Florence received the go ahead from Weld County
 - -Set to begin in January 2024, board previously approved, but then continued with Crime star Board can vote on again at next regular meeting

2. Baseball Field

- -Sports field, south side of town
- -GoCo and other grants available, next due by 10/23
- -Need to assign a committee and hold a meeting
- -Posting on Town site, who would like to join

3. Road's update

- -Weld County meeting:
 - -Traffic study and now CR 100 is a primary plow route, CR 126 secondary route then Carr out to I-25
 - -CR 98, mag down all the way to CR 39 then CR 39 to CR 100
 - -Dust suppressant on CR 98 and CR 31, by County
 - -Snow boss connections for Kyle
- -Blade roads around park for Nunn Days
- -Truck traffic on Railroad, need to address a few sign issues, then education and enforcement of Truck Route

4. Sunrise Solar

- -Xcel is capacity constrained for Town, local businesses cannot setup utilities because Xcel will not service
- -Micro grid, large solar array, battery back up at night
- -Require significant work in regards to billing
- -Inter-connection agreements with additional utility company, required by law
- -Can sell unused, un stored power
- -Might be feasible for the Town, might not, but worth looking into
- -Solar committee, Adam will be the chair
- -Will need additional storage tank for water

5. 2024 Budge Planning

- -As of July, we are under budget about \$67,000.00
- -Should receive estimate of mill levy in the next month
- -What large expenses, within each department, are we looking at for next year
 - -Public Works; next year or two to replace the Dodge and purchase a skid steer, barricades
 - -Public Safety; clear lease on 2016 vehicle
 - -Board of Trustees- raise

- -Kioni, in charge of volunteers, list of senior residents in Town who need assistance
- -Cathy check with CIRSA regarding coverage of FFA members, possibly help with mowing
- -Help with Nunn Days

Committee Updates:

- b. Finance/Budget/Personnel
 - -Sue almost finished with Municode
- c. Public Safety
 - -Chief Florence in office, working hard to get PD organized, Lance a great help
 - -Job posting is up for another officer
 - one potential candidate who has submitted resume, posting closes on 9/26
- d. Public Works
- e. Public Outreach/Events Committee
 - -Nunn Days on 23rd:
 - -banners will be here soon
 - -judges for car show
 - -Ault will be in parade
 - -movie will be Super Mario Bros.
 - -transport Board of Trustees on a fire truck
 - -Suicide prevention banners are up

 - -We need to be consistently looking out for grants, they help to keep us under budget
