 -will face Grant Ave., located South of house, only electric, concrete floor

- 3. Review of Ben Issa LLC-Economic Development analysis by Upstate Colorado
 - -Trustee Kaus explained specifics of processing the animals to meet Kosher qualifications, believes it would be good for the town, another business bringing in employee's, residents, and revenue

- e. Code Enforcement/Emergency Planning- Trustee Cable:
 - -Review renewal for IGA for Victim Assistance Services, required by State Weld County no longer receiving grant to fund, Greeley will continue but with a price increase from \$1,500.00 to \$2,500.00.

 - -Chief Smith reviewed stats from last meeting
 - -since Jan. 45 calls assisting other agencies, 10% of our calls
 - -helps builds relationships, be able to depend on each other
 - -other agencies have assisted us 88 times this year
 - -Tahoe issues
 - -requires a jump start, battery and alternator are good some sort of electrical issue
 - no cage, requires calling another agency to transport
 - -State Patrol switching out their dodge chargers, vehicles equipped with everything we would need, except radio, we have extra radio cost would be \$9500.00, then decommission Tahoe at auction and cost should wash each other out
 - *Board will vote on at Regular Meeting October 20th 2022 to pre approve amount, if one becomes available prior to 10/20/2022 Board can vote on by email
- f. Senior Outreach/Facilities- Trustee Amen:
 - -Monument, potential cost \$50,000.00 total; \$30,000.00 for monument, additional \$20,000.00 for concrete pad and benches, flag pole's
 - -CPR/First Aid classes, Mayor Moon trying to set up free First Aid class for community with option to pay/attend additional CPR class
 - -planting at Senior Center, possible Garden/raised beds in the future
 - -tap into well that feeds the park and use it for Senior Center

g. Nunn Days:

- -Thank You to all board members for attending, few complaints, lots of compliments
- -T shirt sales were down, several still available for purchase at reduced price
- -Suggestion, have at least 2 face painters next year
- -raised 5k this year, overflow going to help fund Christmas party
- -Plan to begin raising money at beginning of 2023 for next Nunn Days

Public Works:

- -purchase skid steer, sell Kabota tractor, nothing lost by not having a tractor, per Heather, forks we have now would work on skid steer
- -roller, help with road maintenance, price does vary based on where/what specific type you purchase
- -improve mowers
- -Dodge shop truck is on its last leg
- -per Cathy, job/equipment sharing with municipalities is unlikely
 - -difficult to track hours, tasks completed, etc.
 - -more beneficial to hire additional help, especially for road grading
- -mini excavator
- -seasonal employee for summer
- -road base, increase budget for 2023, possibly double
- -check into Grants available

Parks and Recreation:

- -requesting \$30-50k to improve Park, including bathrooms
- -issue with permanent restrooms it they must be maintained
- as opposed to porta potty's that are maintained by someone else
- -improving playground etc., adding exercise course, apply for grants
- -upgrade to ADA porta potty as a trail run, more room

Events/Classes:

- -increase base budget to \$5,000.00 + fundraising and donations
- -keep costs down for attendees

Police Services/Equipment:

- -15-20% increase from last year
- -\$15,000.00 just for equipment
